The session was arranged for all the students irrespective of their courses and years. Over 116 students attended the session. The session began with a very warm welcome of the session, Dr. Preeti with a token of love in the form of a virtual bouquet giving ceremony by team MOHUR.

The speaker took the webinar forward by informing about Resume and how it helps us to network and connect. She gave a glimpse of the job market. We got to know about ATS. We learnt about the content of the resume (name, address, contact, mail, experience etc.) She told us how to make our resume presentable like- It should be clean, readable, simple yet attractive. She advised to use keywords and never to copy paste in order to avoid rejection.

She gave us a guide to get started and emphasised on having a LinkedIn profile, **It compliments your resume**. If you want to make a good resume, you should introspect first and start making a master document. Write most about yourself. **It is a big help.**

The speaker threw some light upon the different formats of a resume:

1. **Chronological** – for fresher graduates
2. **Function** – for people with work experience
3. **Hybrid**

To make it more understandable she showed various samples. She suggested the proper format of the resume and the right placement of contents like internships, skills, interests and the projects undertaken. The speaker gave special attention to Experience: The Heart of Resume, right way to showcase soft skills and hard skills in relevance to the job.

At the end, she advised to work on the master document and experience. We got a glimpse of the attributes that Employer's seek. We learnt the Do's and don'ts of a resume. The speaker told us about the cover letter and how it's is an additional opportunity to showcase your profile. The session was very informative and interactive. The speaker addressed students queries with utmost sincerity.

They gave words of encouragement and valuable suggestions about the key factors to be kept in mind while starting and running a business.



## **Report - Webinar on“Library & Information Science as a Profession” on 16th July, 2021 at 11am**






## **Pratibha Feedback and Assessment Report, 2021-2022**

Janki Devi Memorial College (JDMC), University of Delhi, under Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has successfully completed the fifth batch of Pratibha: foundation classes (competitive exams) under the convenorship of Dr. Md. Zubeer Ahmed and four co-conveners; Dr. Khachungla Chalhang, Dr. Debahuti Brahmachari, Mr Ahirrao Dinesh Bharat, Mr. Raju Keshari and Dr. Pavan Kumar. Students, who aim to clear the various competitive exams conducted by UPSC, State Public Service Commission etc. opted for these classes. The primary objective of these foundation classes was to provide the basic knowledge about important topics from examination point of view, and orient the students to explore further on their own. The topics for lectures were selected keeping in mind the general studies component of various competitive exams.

The classes were open for all bonafide students and (female&male) ex-students of the University of Delhi. The classes began on 13<sup>th</sup> August 2021, whereby 58 students registered for the classes. Out of 58, ten students from Mahatma Gandhi Government College Mayabunder, Andaman and Nicobar Islands were given free registration under Vidya Vistar scheme of JDMC, University of Delhi. The course was divided into 81 modules covering the broad areas of History, Economics, Political Science, Sociology, English, Mathematics, Geography, Science & Technology, Current Affairs, Essay writing and components of Personality test. The classes were taken by the successful candidates in the Civil Services exam, faculties from various departments of the college and experts from outside. One module of two hours was discussed on every Friday and Saturday and two modules of two hours each were discussed on every Sunday. Owing to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic, all the lectures were delivered in online mode. Five online mock tests and five mock test discussion session were held to assess students' learning and performance. Two mentoring sessions were also held to guide students. A District Collector was invited to take an interactive session for students.

Students' feedback was taken and processed for the Pratibha classes and following conclusions were drawn:

Number of students enrolled: 58

Number of students participated in the feedback: 40

The average performance of the foundation classes was found ranging good to excellent in terms of score. But in few areas, it was observed average. Scope of improvement in terms of score was noticed in some areas as the score can be improved for excellent grade.

Students' responses in the form of comments and suggestions are summarised below:

- To cover more topics other than the listed in syllabus- The total number of modules (topics) have already been increased in the sixth batch of Pratibha.
- Teachers to be bilingual- Most of the faculty members deliver their lectures in bilingual method.
- Number of mock tests have already been increased to five (online mode) in the fifth batch of Pratibha.
- Offline mode more effective: Given the ongoing pandemic (Covid), its aftereffects and tight schedule of regular undergraduate classes, it is convenient for both students and faculty members to have the classes in online mode. However, in future, options for offline mode too will be explored.
- To increase the duration for those modules where more topics need to be covered- Keeping in mind the vision of Pratibha classes which is to provide orientation to students and therefore, keeping in mind the time constraint, it is not viable to increase the duration of modules. However, as mentioned above, the number of topics/modules particularly in (Political Science) and therefore, number of lectures have been increased for the sixth batch of Pratibha.

Students expressed that the foundation classes were very helpful and they got benefited in many ways, such as better understanding and exposure of various aspects of competitive exams. It helped them in building a foundation for competitive exams as well as provided an understanding about how to approach the different topics and questions in a competitive exam. They appreciated and acknowledged the rich experience and expertise of resource persons and overall, they found these classes very informative and a significant platform for competitive exams.



Although constitutional reforms were due only in 1929, the Conservative government, then in power in Britain, feared defeat by the Labour Party and thus did not want to leave the question of the future of Britain's most prized colony in "irresponsible Labour hands". Also by the mid-1920s, the failure of the 1919 Act to create a stable imperial power had led to several parliamentary reports and inquiries. The Lee Commission went into the Raj's failure to recruit enough British officers; the Mudiman Commission looked into the deadlock within the diarchic dispensation; and the Linlithgow Commission inquired into the crisis of Indian agriculture. In 1967 the founder of Nirma **Washing powder** Karsanbhai Khodidas Patel approached the Entrepreneurship Office of Ahmedabad and was given a project guide titled "**How to Create Washing Powder and Everything Related to It.**" He truly won people's hearts, and he hasn't looked back since. The Entrepreneurship Office offered him the guidance that is required for anyone to attain their life goals.

The host then handed over the mic to Shri Neeraj Sharma, who started the discussion on the significance of celebrating women's day. He then moved further and told the students about the MSME sector of India, he also told the students about one of the biggest schemes of the government of India i.e. STARTUP INDIA and Standup INDIA. Startup India is the idea of DRIIT and the Department of Science & Technology that helps the new entrepreneurs by laying focus on three stages i.e. IDEATION STAGE, PROTOTYPE, COMMERCIALISATION. Standup India focuses on people who belong to unprivileged sections of the society i.e ST and SC people and women. It provides loans to start the business by banks. 75% of funds are provided by the government and the person has to bring 25% contribution on their own. Then he introduced various other schemes like





**1. Brief report:**

The course “Legal Literacy” commenced with 11 students on 5<sup>th</sup> August, 2021. During the 30hours course, the students were introduced to various concepts, missions, and objectives of legal literacy. Besides, every week, a fundamental right of Indian citizen was discussed with students. Remaining true to the mission of the ‘Legal Literacy’

launched by the

government, the purpose of the course is to simplify the language of the law to make people able to understand laws and judgments with special focus on the marginalised sections of the society. Various resource persons were invited throughout the programme to offer the best understanding of the course to the students. The first unit introduced the idea and concept of legal literacy to students informing them about the meaning, philosophy, and approaches to legal literacy. One of the key fundamental rights of Indian Citizens—Food Security Act, 2013—was discussed. Familiarizing students with the goals & objectives and the vision of legal literacy, the second unit articulated the need of legal literacy. SCs/STs Prevention of Atrocities Act, 1989/2006 was discussed depicting the importance of legal literacy. The third unit provided students with a deeper understanding of the concepts of legal literacy by exploring the legal aid movement in India and other parts of the world. The framework of legal service authorities was discussed to construe the application of the concept. A detailed overview of Right to Information Act, 2005 was offered to learn about its use and method of filing for RTI online and offline. Highlighting the aim of spreading legal literacy in India, the fourth unit informed students regarding the National Legal Literacy Mission, its aims, objectives, target groups, and its implementation. Right to Education, 2009, an integral part of legal rights in India, allowed students to know about the basic literacy rights of Indian citizens. After studying the fifth unit, students were able to develop a nuanced understanding of the relationship between internet and legal literacy. Besides, the unit also detailed on the laws pertaining to women enhancing the knowledge of legal rights of women. The sixth unit educated students about the free legal aid offered by law to safeguard the basic constitutional rights of citizens. The unit also discussed the idea, function, and significance of Lok Adalats in India. In the final unit, students learned about the procedure of criminal case proceedings. The students were introduced to the legal proceedings in India. Each class was followed by an interactive session.

## 2. Evaluation Method

The course culminated with a subjective terminal assessment. At the end of the course, students were marked on the basis of an Open Book Examination.
